CHAMP (Champlain Adaptive Mounted Program) is a 20 year old organization which offers therapeutic horse-back riding lessons to those with a variety of challenges. Without volunteers, this program can not function. As a volunteer you will enjoy working with the riders and the horses and you will find the smiles and excitement of the riders very rewarding. The riders have physical and/or psychological challenges. When riding a horse, the "problems" of life are forgotten and it is all about having fun, learning a new skill and developing self-confidence. It is helpful if a volunteer has experience around horses but this is not necessary. Duties of a volunteer include: grooming and tacking up the horses, being a horse leader, and being a horse side walker.
