- Make sure your schedule meets your credit and future interests needs
- Consider a new sport or club. Register for Sports Team credit with your BHS coach

#### October/ November

- ☐ Take the PSAT in October
- Consider part-time volunteer or job experiences related to your career plans
- ☐ Take advantage of meeting with college representatives online or in the cafeteria low risk opportunity to hear about schools

#### **December**

- PSAT scores are available. Sign into your CollegBoard.org account to review them and your Khan Academy site
- □ Students will receive their test books. Review questions you answered incorrectly. Use this test to help study for the SAT

- ☐ The Program of Studies for senior year courses is distributed. Work with your counselor and parent/guardian to make the best selection. Consider college admissions requirements, not just high school credit requirements
- Meet with your counselor to begin searches for colleges, trade/technical schools or other post secondary options
- Attend BHS Junior College and Post Secondary Night

- ☐ Course selection for your senior year Challenge yourself!
- Sign up for April, May or June standardized tests Fee waivers for qualified students are in the Guidance office
- ☐ Use February break to visit colleges/technical schools

- Use Naviance to explore schools
- February 11 Registration deadline for March SAT
- ☐ February 25 Registration deadline for April ACT
