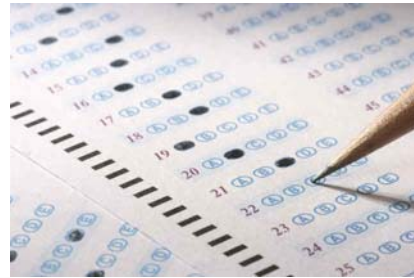
UPCOMING SAT CLASS
