# A unique semester experience for BHS students exploring real world issues in Burlington.

This Fall, BHS is launching a new program for interested students in grades 10-12: the *Burlington City & Lake Semester [BCL]*. The program takes students out of the classroom and into the city to study real world issues and take action to improve our community.

### The City & Lake Program

BCL is about responding to our community's needs and opportunities. Potential projects:

- Creating a short documentary film about Burlington's people and neighborhoods to share with families moving to the city.
- Studying Lake Champlain health with scientists and presenting results to the City Council.
- Collaborating with a professional artist to create art for one of the city's public parks.



#### **Schedule and Credit**

BCL students will meet downtown all day on Blue Days and at BHS for one block on White Days. Students earn Social Studies, English, and General Electives credits in the program. Students can enroll in three other classes at BHS on White Days (e.g. Math, Science, Foreign Language, Art).
