## Burlington High School Parking Registration / Regulations Contract

Before any BHS parking permit is issued, the student driver and the parent/guardian of the student driver must enter the following contract. Parking at Burlington High School is a privilege and not a right. The School Department assumes no liability for damage, fire, theft to vehicles. Violators who are illegally parked can be fined and towed. The administration or his/her designee reserves the right to determine the seriousness of any infraction and issue the consequences deemed appropriate.

- 1. You must be a BHS/BTC Junior or Senior student to request a parking permit.
- 2. **Proof of** registration, insurance, and a valid license must be shown to the School Personnel prior to the issuance of a parking permit. These items must remain valid for the duration of the school year. Should any of the items expire; the student's parking permit can be revoked.
- 3. If at anytime during the school year, you are no longer enrolled or taking classes at BHS/BTC, you will be considered ineligible for a parking permit and you will be required to turn in your permit to the School Personnel.
- 4. All permit holders are required to clearly display their permit. Placement of the permit will be hanging, clearly visible on the rearview mirror. The permit must be visible and readable at all times. Snow and dirt needs to be removed at all times making the permit visible.
- 5. It is **NEVER** acceptable to allow another student to use your parking permit.
- 6. Students are obligated to park only in the student parking lots located on the south side of Institute Road. Parking permits are required at all times for students when school is in session (e.g. 7:30 AM 4:00 PM). Students coming back for meetings or practices later in the afternoon or evening do not need permits.
- 7. Students are expected to obey all other parking regulations.

BHS **WILL NOT REIMBURSE** FOR THE TOWING OF VEHICLES. Should a tow truck arrive, the tow company may require payment before a vehicle will be released. This is referred to as a "Hook and Release Fee."

## VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED AND/OR PERMITS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED FOR:

- PARKING WITHOUT A PERMIT
- PARKING WITHOUT A PERMIT VISIBLE OR READABLE
- PARKING IN ANY NONDESIGNATED PARKING SPOTS
- PARKING ON ANY OF THE BHS FIELDS/GRASS EXCEPT WHEN CLEARLY MARKED FOR SPECIAL EVENTS
- PARKING IN ANY OF THE FACULTY LOTS
- PARKING IN FIRE OR BUS LANE
- PARKING IN THE MAINTENACE/DELIVERY AREA
- LOAN/TRANSFER/GIVE/SELL YOUR PERMIT TO ANOTHER PERSON
- ANY OTHER INFRACTION DEEMED TO BE INVIOLATION OF EXPECTED STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT
- DRIVING UNDERCLASSMAN DURING THE SCHOOL DAY (LUNCHES/FREE BLOCKS)
