# BHS Among Nine Schools to Advance to Scholars' Bowl State Championship

The Vermont-NEA Scholars' Bowl playoffs got underway with preliminary-round competition this past Saturday, January 30th, 2021. Of the many schools participating on the Varsity level, nine advanced to compete in the state championship, Burlington High School Varsity Team (Wyatt Harte (Captain), Rory Stein, Theo Ellis-Novotny, and Robbie Safran) among them.

Hanover was the only team in the Varsity field to go undefeated, winning all four of their matches for the day. Their undefeated streak upset previously undefeated Champlain Valley Union High School, topping them 215-205 during Saturday's competition to secure first place.

CVU, Essex High School, BHS, and South Burlington High School all finished the day 3-1, securing their place at championships. The other schools to advance with a 2-2 record were Bellows Free Academy, BFA St. Albans, Lamoille Valley Union High School, Lyndon Institute, and Middlebury Union High School.

Burlington B team (Sam Silberman (Captain), Miles Ellis-Novotny, Dylan Severson, Tido Schulman, Isaac Doggett, Quinn Shelley, and Connor Reutter) won the title in the JV Bracket, going undefeated for the day with a 4-0 record, including a 175-155 victory over Essex B in the final.



New 4-H Teen Time Opportunity - Critical Conversations

Join 4-H in the **Critical Conversations** around race and justice, and learn how to unlock your leadership potential to inspire change. Participants will be guided by Extension educators in conversations and activities to help youth understand topics such as racism, implicit bias, equity, culture and discrimination and learn how to facilitate difficult conversations. The goal of these sessions is to help youth learn how to carefully examine the issue, weigh costs and consequences, and discuss possible courses of action. **Open to ALL youth in grades 7-12** from Vermont and beyond. Space is limited to 40 participants. (Please do not register until you are 100% committed to attending.) **This is a virtual program that will meet over Zoom on March 6 & 7 from 4-6 pm each day.** 

#### Some other 4-H Programs include:

**Designing Your Future** - starts on Feb 3! Sessions are recorded in case you can't make them all.

**Shaping Your Future** - full scholarships to attend the virtual National 4-H Conference; applications due by Feb 10. Vermont youth only, grades 9-12 are eligible for the scholarships **Croak, Slither and Slide** - a 6-week exploration of frogs, toads, snakes, salamanders, turtles, caecilians, and all sorts of other kin! Starts on February 25!

**Babysitting** - The Youth Babysitting course is designed to help middle school and teenaged youth learn what it takes to be a responsible, caring, trustworthy, competent, capable, and safe babysitter. New sessions just added!

**VTeen Science Exploration** - join us every Wednesday afternoon from 3:30 - 4:45 pm at our weekly virtual teen science cafe where you will meet a scientist, learn about their work, explore different science pathways, engage in informal discussions and ask questions. Open to all youth in grades 7-12 in Vermont and beyond.
