Graduation on the Horizon - What's Next?

As the year draws to a close, we are working tirelessly to plan end of year festivities and traditions, many of which we were not able to partake in last year due to COVID.

Perhaps the largest undertaking for the end of the year is Graduation. While we were able to get creative last year and utilize our parking lot for a drive through celebration over the span of three days, this year we are planning to do something more traditional, albeit still different.

While this year is still not our usual graduation ceremony, a poll conducted earlier this year among graduates indicated that they would like their graduation to be "as traditional as possible" despite the lack of building and COVID restrictions.

This year, our commencement will be held outside. Typically Graduation is located in the gymnasium at BHS. With the closure of the campus at 52 institute road due to PCBs, coupled with COVID restrictions for indoor gatherings, we have moved the 2021 graduation site outdoors to the athletic complex.

BHS traditions, such as the Faculty Gauntlet and the ringing of the bell, were also identified as important moments that the graduating class of 2021 wanted involved with their ceremony. Thankfully, due to Vermont's reopening plans, these are two traditions we will be able to honor this year for our Seahorses.

Lastly, the number of tickets available will be two per graduate, in order to stay within COVID gathering

guidelines and to ensure the safety of those most vulnerable within our community. As always, RETN (now called The Media Factory) will be streaming the graduation ceremony live on local TV for those who cannot attend in person.

We will be sending more information via email to graduates and their families within the next few weeks, so please keep an eye on your inboxes! Rory Stein, Oboe - 11th Grade


Tatiana Byam, Cello - 10th Grade

The state began distributing P-EBT cards to all Burlington families with students. [Here are the state-issued FAQ's about the P-EBT cards in multiple languages to review.](#)

The cards that have been distributed need to be activated by the recipient before using them for any purpose. The activation information is card-specific. A letter preceded the actual card with activation information about the process. The card can then be used much like a debit card as long as the user has the PIN number for the card.

Important Reminder: The cards will be loaded with additional funds in July. Families should keep the cards for the next disbursement.

If families are not in need, the card may be used to buy food and donate it to a local food shelf. Using the card to purchase food and donate the food helps the community and keeps the benefits in Burlington!
