
SIGNING UP FOR EXAMS

Courses are set:

Teachers have set up their courses with the College Board (CB) system.

Students have their portals:

For each class, your student has the portal link that registers them for the exam and provides access to support materials for the course and other course-related materials the teacher may choose to use – or not.



SIGNING UP FOR EXAMS

Exam Only:

Students who need the exam only – and are not in an approved AP course – need to contact their school counselor or reach out to AP Coordinator Fran Brock (fbrock@bsdvt.org) by the deadline date of **October 29** so an exam will be ordered.

Deadline for a change of mind – a student decides to take or not to take the exam – at BHS is **Tuesday, November 9, 2021.**

PENALTIES

Once the exams are ordered on **November 15** –

there is a **Penalty Cost**:

any change of mind will cost
the student \$40 for each changed exam,
set by the College Board.
