# **Burlington High School Community Service Program**

At BHS, students are required to volunteer for 10 hours per year of their enrollment as a requirement for graduation.

### **Reporting Volunteer Hours**

- 1. Use this <u>Community Service Form</u> to report hours by completing the top section and sending it to your supervisor. They can also be picked up in the Counseling Office, room 113.
- 2. Return the completed Community Service Form physically to room 113 or in an email to BHS Counseling at BHSCounseling@bsdvt.org.

## Which activities count toward my requirement?

- Any service for a non-profit organization (*i.e.* King Street Youth Center, Sara Holbrook Center, Boys and Girls Club, Humane Society, American Red Cross)
- See this list from the <u>United Way of Northwest</u> Vermont to find a location
- Look for emails from BHS Counseling and BHS Heroes that have opportunities

## Which activities DO NOT COUNT toward my requirement?

- Volunteering at for-profit organizations
- Participation in church services
- Caring for pets
- Babysitting
- Helping relatives
- Any volunteer work that is done during school hours
- Using physical donations or fundraising dollars to replace your contribution of time
  - e.g. You can't earn 1 hour of service per canned food item donated or earn 5 service hours for every \$100 raised for a project
